Install

- 2. Exit all applications that are running.
- 3. Insert the supplied CD-ROM into the CD-ROM drive of the computer.
- 4. Double-click the setup program.

- 5. For the remainder of the procedure, follow the instructions shown on the screen.
 - When the "User Account Control" dialog box appears, click "Yes" (or "Allow").
 - When a security warning screen (The publisher could not be verified.) appears, click "Allow".
- 6. When the installation finished screen appears, click "Finish".

This completes the installation of this software.


How to use

Starting this software

Follow the steps below to start this software.

- On the desktop, double-click the "SHARP Information Display Downloader" shortcut icon ().
- Click the "Start" button, and then select "All Programs" "SHARP Information Display Downloader" "SHARP Information Display Downloader".

Main Screen



- 1. A list of software programs etc. that can be downloaded, already downloaded versions, and the latest version appears. You can change the list by clicking the tab.
- 2. Cancel all selections in the list.

If nothing is selected in the list, select all displayed items.

- 3. Refresh the list.
- 4. Files of software programs etc. selected in the list will be downloaded. Downloaded files will be saved in the previously specified folder (below).
- 5. Show the folder where the downloaded file is saved.
- 6. Configure settings for this software.

Add shortcut to Startup:

Specify whether you want to add this software to Startup.

When added to Startup, this software will automatically check for the latest version each time your computer is started. If there is a new version, a notice will appear in the task tray.



In this case, follow the steps below to start this software.

- Click the notice.
- Click on the task tray, and click "Open".

Download folder:

Specify the folder where you want to save the downloaded file.

- 7. Select to show only applications that support the products set in "Filtering settings". (See page 5.)
- 8. Show a list of the models to be filtered. (See page 5.)
- 9. Select to hide software programs etc. that have already been downloaded.
- 10. If checked, the operation manual will not be displayed in the list. (Excludes the "Manual" tab.)

TIPS

· Download information is recorded in this software.

The version shown in "Downloaded version" and the action of "Hide downloaded files" are based on that information. Even if there are no files in the downloaded file folder, for example when you have deleted the files, the files are treated as already downloaded.

■ Procedure

- 1. Select the software programs etc. to be downloaded in the list.
- 2. Click 🛂 .

The download will start.

When the download finished, a message appears. Click "OK".


3. Click ____.

The folder where the downloaded file is saved appears.

Filtering settings

Click "Filtering settings" to show a list of the product.

You can select products to show in the list only the applications that support those products.
